Two-Gun Bob commemorates Howards centennial with an anthology of thirteen new and reprinted essays on Howard, ranging from Glenn Lords study of Howards early amateur press work to Fred Blossers look at Howards detective writing; from Charles Hoffmans analysis of Howards portrayal of character to S.T. Joshis placement of the Bran Mak Morn stories in the context of Roman history; from Charles Gramlichs psychological study of Howard to Michele Tetros survey of Howards poetry.
